How to use eye ointment

- 1. Read the instructions on the label and treat only the eye stated.
- 2. If you think you may have difficulty using the eye ointment it may be better to get someone to do it for you.
- 3. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser if water is not available.
- 4. Take the cap off the tube. Avoid touching the top of the ointment.
- 5. Lie down or sit with your head tilted back.
- 6. Pull down the lower lid of the eye to form a pouch or pocket and look up.
- Gently apply a strip of ointment (about 1cm) inside the inner surface of the lower lid, trying not to touch the eye or the eyelid with the top of the tube.
- 8. Close the eye for two minutes.
- 9. Remove any excess ointment from your eyelashes with a clean tissue.
- 10. Replace the cap on the tube and store the tube in a cool place.

Handy tips:

- Take the medicine as instructed by your doctor.
- If you miss a dose do not try to catch up by taking two or three missed doses at once.
- Your vision may be blurred for a short time afterwards. Don't drive or operate machinery until you can see clearly again.
- Keep all medicines out of the reach of children. Avoid taking medicine in front of young children they may copy your behaviour.
- Never share your medicines, even if someone else has similar symptoms.

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
